Key Responsibilities and Accountabilities:

- Perform labor activities including but not limited to lawn mowing, spraying for pests and weed control, digging holes, trenching, shoveling rock, pulling weeds, and other labor-intensive tasks.
- Installation of landscapes including planting, native turf seeding, erosion control, rough/fine grading, mulch, and soil amendments.
- Installation of complete irrigation systems including assembly and testing.
- Perform site preparation including removal of vegetation, debris, rock, concrete, soil removal and general site clean-up.
- Installation of retaining walls, pavers, flagstone, decorative rock, and a variety of other landscape construction activities.
- Perform all tasks associated with completion of landscape construction projects.
- Must have valid drivers license
- Attend weekly safety meeting
- Ability to lift 50 pounds
- Other duties as assigned by Supervisory Staff
